- Genesis 39:2-6a, "***And the LORD was with Joseph, so he became a successful man. And he was in the house of his master, the Egyptian.***"
- Verse 2 – "***The LORD was with Joseph and he prospered.***"
- Verse 3 – "***The LORD was with him and... The LORD gave him success in everything he did.***"
- Verse 5 – "The LORD blessed the household of the Egyptian because of Joseph."

II. BE FAITHFUL TO HIM (vs.6-20)
